



## Dogs are Welcome

We are happy to welcome a maximum of two small or one medium sized adult dog in Minton, our dog friendly room, provided they are well behaved and house-trained. Minton, has its own entrance to the car park and is one of our larger rooms. The room can either be a Twin or Double.

Please let us know when you book the room if you are bringing your dog, and we look forward to welcoming them. Regretfully, we do charge £10 per visit, per dog (not per night) for the extra cleaning involved.

We realise that not all guests appreciate dogs so for everyone's comfort we ask dog owners to kindly observe the following:

- We regret the garden isn't fully secured, but we can recommend plenty of local walks ideal for taking your dog out for an early morning or late evening walk.
- Dogs should never be left alone in the bedroom when you go out - both of our local pubs are dog-friendly places to eat in the evenings so there should be no need to leave dogs unattended except at breakfast.
- We would appreciate if you did not bring your dog into the breakfast room, lounge or bar unless you are the only guests in the B&B.
- Please keep your dog under control at all times and be mindful that not everyone likes dogs, so don't let your dog approach other guests unless they encourage it.
- Your dog must be up-to-date with flea and worming treatments
- Please dispose of dog waste using bio-gradable bags in the black bin in the car park by the shed. If you run out of bags, please let us know.
- Please do not let your dogs on any of the furniture, including beds.
- Please bring your own dog bedding/blankets to help them feel at home and so that they are not sleeping directly on the carpet. We supply food and water bowls.
- Should your dog have an unfortunate accident in the bedroom, please let us know so that we can dispose of any mess appropriately; any damage or excessive cleaning may incur an additional charge, at our discretion.
- We'd be grateful if you could wipe down muddy paws before going into the bedroom, there is an outside tap available should you need to wash down your muddy dog after a walk. Please ask if you would like a dog towel.
